By Rail

Railway station, continue straight ahead along Midland Road to the traffic lights and turn left onto London Road. Stay on London Road for approximately 1 mile to the traffic island at Alvaston. Go straight on and at the next traffic island turn right onto the ring road A5111. The rest is as from 'South of England'.

Bus station

Exit and turn right at the Cock Pitt island, take the first exit at the island Station Approach and continue onto the Railway Station on the right. The rest is as above.

Public Transport

How to find us

East Midlands Airport:

Take the A453 following signs to the M1 north (junction 24). At junction 24 of the M1, take the A50 following signs for Derby (A6). After 4 miles join the A6, following the signs for Derby. At the roundabout junction (Blue peter), turn left onto the Ring Road (A5111) following signs for the Moorways Leisure Centre. Go straight through the roundabout at the Spider Bridge. Turn left at the next set of traffic lights onto Moor Lane. Continue to the end of Moor Lane and the the Rools-Royce Sinfin sites are to your left and right. Aero Engine Controls is next to the Learning and Development Centre.

South of England:

Travelling on the M1, leave the motorway at Junction 25. Take the first exit A52 Derby for approximately 5 miles before bearing left on the Ring Road A5111 and at the second traffic island (Alvaston) turn left. At the next traffic island turn left onto Moor Lane, continue to the end and the Rools-Royce Sinfin sites are to your left and right. Aero Engine Controls is next to the Learning and Development Centre.

North of England

Travelling on the M1, leave the motorway at Junction 25. the rest is as above..

West of England

Travelling on the M5/M42 which becomes the A42 at Junction 11. Continue on until you reach Junction 24 – M1, take the A50 Derby road until you reach the Derby Ring Road (A5111). The rest is as East Midlands Airport above.

East of England

Travelling into Derby on the A52 from Nottingham take the exit marked Ring Road A5111. At the second traffic island (Alvaston) turn left and at the next turn right A5111. The rest is as East Midlands Airport above.
